Day 1 Paro – Thimpu (Dinner)

- Arrival at Paro airport.
- Immigration formalities completed.
- Baggage collected.
- Meeting with representative.
- Drive to Thimpu (distance: 55 km, duration: Approximately 1.5 hours)
- Stop at Chuzon.
- Confluence of Thimpu and Paro rivers.
- Arrival in Thimpu and hotel check-in.
- Explore Thimphu, a unique city blending modern development with ancient traditions.
- Take an evening walk around Thimphu Main Street and market area.
- Visit the Local Crafts Bazaar to shop for traditional Bhutanese arts and crafts.
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Thimphu.

Day 2 Thimpu (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Proceed for Thimpu Valley sightseeing.
- Visit the National Library, Textile Museum and Simply Bhutan
- Lunch break.
- Short drive (15km) to Pangri Zampa and visit the 16th-century monastery, one of Bhutan's oldest
- Visit Buddha Point (Kuensel Phodrang), short drive from Thimpu City Centre and get overview of Thimphu Valley from Buddha Point
- Visit King's Memorial Chorten
- Visit Trashichhoedzong.
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Thimphu.

Day 3 Thimpu – Punakha (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Drive to Punakha (distance: 75 km, duration: Approximately 3 hours)
- Pass through Dochula Pass.
- Arrival in Punakha and hotel check-in.
- Explore Punakha Dzong.
- Excursion to Chimi Lhakhang
- Evening exploration of Punakha Village
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Punakha.

- Explore Ta Dzong.
- Short trail to Rinpung Dzong.
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Paro.

Day 6 Paro (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Excursion to Taktshang Monastery or Tigers Nest.
- Hike lasting approximately 5 hours.
- In the afternoon, drive to Drukgyel Dzong
- Continue visit Kyichu Lhakhang in the evening
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Paro.

Day 7 Departure (Breakfast)

- Early breakfast at the hotel.
- Proceed to the airport.
- Flight to onward destination.
- Assistance with exit formalities by representative.
- Farewell bid.
