TASHKENT –SAMARKAND – SHAKHRISABZ – BUKHARA – KHIVA - TASHKENT
(HOP ON TOUR)
(MIN 2 TO GO)

Day 1 Kuala Lumpur – Tashkent (D)

- Upon arrival at Tashkent International Airport, meet and greet by our representative.
- Transfer to hotel and check in
- Dinner at local restaurant
- Overnight at hotel in Tashkent

Day 2 Tashkent – Samarkand (Approx. 300km - 5hrs) (Breakfast/Dinner)

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Meet with the guide at the hotel lobby and star excursion in Tashkent.
- Proceed visit Hazrat Imam Monument, Sheikhtaur Memorial Complex, Jami Mosque, Kukaldash Madrassa, Chorsu Bazaar, Independence Square and Amir Temur Square.
- Then, drive to Samarkand.
- Upon arrival, transfer to hotel and check in.
- Dinner at local restaurant.
- Overnight stay at hotel in Samarkand.

Day 3 Samarkand (Breakfast/Dinner)

- Breakfast at hotel
- Start the excursion in Samarkand, one of the oldest cities in the world.
- Visit the tomb of Temurids - Gur Emir (1404).
- Then, continue visit Registan Square (1415-1660), which includes three madrassas: Ulugbek (1417), Sher Dor (1636), and Tilla Kori (1660).
- Walk along Tashkent Street to Bibi Khanym Mosque (1404), built by Amir Temur for his beloved wife.
- Shopping in the Siab Market to experience the national atmosphere.
- Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Samarkand.

Day 4 Samarkand (Breakfast/Dinner)

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Continue the excursion around Samarkand.
- Proceed visit the mausoleum of St. Doniyor, The ruins of the Afrosiab settlement and Tthe "Meros" paper factory.
- Learn about the ancient tradition of making paper using Samarkand technologies.
- Observe the paper-making process from mulberry tree bark.
- Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 5 Samarkand – Shakhrisabz – Bukhara (Approx. 450km – 7hrs) (Breakfast/Dinner)

- Early breakfast at the hotel.
- Drive to Bukhara through Shakhrisabz.
- Begin the excursion in Shakhrisabz.
- Visit the ruins of the palace of Amir Timur - Ak Saray.
- Then visit the memorial complex Dorut Tilovat, including:
 - Mausoleum of Sheikh Shamsuddin Kulal
 - Mausoleum of Gumbazi Seiydan
 - Mosque Kuk Gumbaz
- Continue the journey to Bukhara.
- Visit a mountain village on the way.
- Upon arrival in Bukhara, transfer to hotel and check in
- Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight stay at the hotel in Bukhara.

Day 6 Bukhara (Breakfast/Dinner)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Start the tour in Bukhara, the "dome of Islam."
- Visit Lyabi House architectural complex, including:
 - Kukeldash madrasah
 - Devonbegi khanaka
 - Devonbegi madrasah (16th-17th centuries)
- Walk through the narrow streets of Bukhara.
- Visit shopping domes.
- Visit Poi Kalyan architectural complex, including:
 - Kalyan mosque
 - Miri Arab madrasah
 - Kalyan Minaret (12th-16th centuries)
- Visit Ulugbek and Abdulaziz Khan Madrasahs.
- Visit Ark Citadel (18th - early 20th centuries).
- Visit the mausoleum of the Samanid dynasty.
- Dinner at a local restaurant and folklore show.
- Overnight stay at hotel in Bukhara.

Day 7 Bukhara – Khiva (Approx. 420km – 7-8hrs) (Breakfast/Dinner)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Proceed to Khiva
- Upon arrival, check in hotel
- Dinner at a local restaurant
- Overnight stay at hotel in Khiva.

Day 8 Khiva (Breakfast/Dinner)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Start the excursion in Khiva.
- Visit Ichan Kala, a UNESCO World Heritage site, Kunya Ark citadel (14th century) and Muhammad Aminhan Madrasah (18th century).
- See Kalta Minor minaret and visit Muhammad Rakhimkhan 2 madrasah (1871-1876).
- Continue tour to Tash Hauli palace (19th century).

- Proceed visit Allakulikhan Madrasah, visit Said Alauddin’s mausoleum (18th-20th centuries) and Shergazikhan madrasah (1718-1726).
- Then see the minaret of Islam Khoja Mosque (1908-1910).
- Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight stay at hotel in Khiva.

Day 9 Khiva – Tashkent (Approx 1hr 20min by flight) (Breakfast/Dinner)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Visit unique sights around Khiva and drive to Yangiariq village.
- Pass by Oqmajid village, former home of German Mennonites (1883-1935).
- Visit Shayh Muhtor Valiy Mosque and mausoleum complex (20km from Khiva).
- Experience the spiritual atmosphere and blessings from the resident imam.
- Drive back, passing fish farms and Karakum Desert dunes.
- Walk up the dunes to explore desert flora and fauna.
- Return along an irrigation channel connecting lakes and farmland.
- Visit Nurullaboy Palace in Khiva, built in 1912 with a blend of Russian and oriental styles.
- Transfer to Urgench local airport for a flight to Tashkent
- Upon arrival, dinner at a local restaurant
- Transfer to the hotel for check in.
- Overnight stay at hotel in Tashkent.

Day 10 Tashkent (Breakfast)

- Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out.
- Transfer to the center of Tashkent.
- Start the excursion with a visit to the Tashkent Metro, known for its themed mosaics and ceramics.
- Walk through Amir Timur Square, featuring a prominent statue of Tamerlane.
- Drive to the Sacred Heart Cathedral, a 20th-century Roman Catholic Church.
- Explore its beautiful stained-glass windows and Gothic-style architecture.
- Visit the Uzbekistan History Museum, showcasing over a quarter million exhibits across four stories.
- Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Transfer to the International Airport for departure
