



**5D4N KUNMING – SNOW MOUNTAIN & SAKURA (MUSLIM TOUR)

Day 1 Kuala Lumpur – Kunming (No Meal)

- Embark on your flight in the evening to Kunming, the capital city of Southwest China's Yunnan.

Day 2 Kunming (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Arrive in Kunming at midnight.
- Your professional Muslim expert tour guide will meet you at the arrival hall of the airport with your private vehicle on standby and assists you to your hotel.
- Relax at hotel to recover from the jet lag.
- Join the group Rendezvous at 8:00am in the hotel lobby.
- Proceed to Haigeng Park.
- Engage with the migratory Siberian seagulls at Dianchi Lake and delight in observing the seagulls glide through the sky and plunge into the water in search of food from November to March.
- Lunch at local Muslim restaurant.
- Following the Salat at Shuncheng Mosque, free shopping at Chongren Street.
- Back to hotel.

Day 3 Kunming / Sakura Garden / Stone Forest (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Set off on a 65km excursion to Sakura Garden.
- Following lunch and prayers, proceed to Astaxanthin Factory.
- Visit the Stone Forest, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and geological marvel.
- Walk through labyrinthine paths flanked by majestic stone pillars, sculpted by millions of years of erosion into shapes that resemble ancient trees, mythical creatures, and even human figures.
- Take a break and delve into the Small Stone Forest.
- Transfer to hotel after dinner.

Day 4 Kunming / Snow Mountain (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Set off on a 2.5-hour journey to the majestic Jiaozi Snow Mountain.
- Ascend by cable car to the main center of the mountain.
- Begin your hike to the summit of Jiaozi Snow Mountain.
- Explore the diverse flora and fauna along the way and take in the panoramic views of the surrounding landscape.
- Conclude your adventure with a scenic cable car descent.
- Lunch at a Muslim restaurant and prayers at the mosque nearby.
- Return to Kunming and transfer to hotel after dinner.

Day 5 Kunming - Departure (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Start your day with a visit to Burning Cream Center.
- Then enjoy a relaxed walk through the Dounan Flower Market.
- After lunch, treat yourself to a shopping adventure at the bustling Luosiwan wholesale market.
- As the day winds down, take in the iconic sight of Kunming, the Golden Horse and Jade Rooster Archways.
- Dive into the vibrant nightlife of Kunming at the Nanqiang Night market before heading to the airport for your mid-night departure flight.

- Equip with warm clothing and heavy-duty gloves to brave the icy conditions at high altitude.
- Eye Protection: A pair of sunglasses is necessary to protect your eyes from ultraviolet rays.
- Valid from December 10 2024 till 31 March 2025 (Not valid on Chinese New Year Holiday 28 Jan – 5 Feb 2025)
